

I think that this Competition speaks to the Ethos and one of the “Raison D’êtres” of the PAGB; throughout our 1,000+ Clubs with their 30,000+ photographers who are always willing to exhibit their work and to expose them to critical comment in competition with other photographers. From the ubiquitous monthly Club competitions where the Club can see their work and can then choose the better work to partake in Club Battles. This leads in most Federations to an Annual Salon where the photographer or their Club put forward their work for selection against all the other photographers in the Federation leading to further exposure in the Federations Annual Exhibition.


Finally each Federation chooses from the work available in their Federation to create an entry for this Annual PAGB event – to my mind this continual striving for improvement and achievement of quality and impact is what Amateur Club Photography and the PAGB is all about. There is no doubt in my mind that what will be seen in this Competition is definitely the “Best of British & Northern Ireland Photography in 2015” Each Federation is allowed to enter Colour Prints, Mono Prints, General PDIs and Nature PDIs equivalent to one third of their number of Clubs – but the scores achieved are not aggregated as the bigger Federations would naturally win – the scores are averaged across all the images per Federation so any Federation can win given good selection and it does allow for equal representation for Club Members across the PAGB.

Meet the Judges



Leo Rich ARPS DPAGB EFIAP/g APAGB

Leo first became interested in photography when a schoolboy and self taught himself how to take, process and print films. When colour film became more readily available he changed to colour slide work - though does still print, occasionally.

He joined his first camera club in 1969 and is currently a Hon Life member of Spectrum of Guernsey who he represented at the Southern Photographic Federation and organised a number of "road trips" taking top lecturers and judges over to the Island to give them a taste of what the mainland clubs take for granted. He has been three times President of the Southern Photographic Federation (now Southern Counties) and has represented them on the PAGB Executive for a number of years.

He is Secretary to the Awards for Photographic Merit and completed two years as President in 2015. Leo classes himself as a "jobbing amateur photographer" photographing whatever takes his fancy.

In recent years he has shown a special interest in environmental portraiture and natural history subjects, many of which are taken on his Annual visits to India. He has judged a number of National and International Exhibitions and is also a keen Exhibitor himself with a modicum of success.

Richard Walton FRPS MPAGB EFIAP



My parents gave me my first camera when I was around 8 years old and immediately became hooked. I cut my teeth on black and white photography and continue to particularly enjoy its artistic qualities today. For the next 35 years or so my efforts were confined to recording family events, holidays etc. Then it all changed!

In 1987, captivated by a friend's black and white photographs, I bought a Canon outfit, set up my first darkroom and joined Sittingbourne Photographic Society.

The distinctions trail then beckoned, culminating with awards of Fellowship (FRPS) of the Royal Photographic Society in 2001, followed by Master of the Photographic Alliance of Great Britain (MPAGB) and EFIAP in 2006.

I was invited to join the Licentiate Panel of the RPS in 2001 and additionally became a member of the Visual Art Associateship and Fellowship

Assessment Panel in 2011.

I judge both locally for the Kent County Photographers Association and further afield as an appointed PAGB judge. I am member of the Permajet Lecturers Team. For the past 4 years I've been a member of Invicta Photographic Club near Maidstone.

I enjoy all genres of photography and my own work is fairly wide ranging as far as subject matter is concerned. However, I must confess that my abiding passion remains black and white, although I do admit to dabbling with colour on occasion.

My first serious photographic love was monochrome silver prints from large format negatives, which eventually led to ARPS and FRPS in the Applied & Professional category.

Through the Society's Archaeology and Heritage Group I became an elected member of Council then sat on 'L', 'A' and 'F' Distinction Panels.

A background in lithographic pre-press and printing gave a good introduction to the 'Dark Arts' of digital photography which followed. After years of practice, tons of paper and gallons of ink, I am still an enthusiastic club photographer producing a few decent prints and making a successful DPAGB application.

Having served as KCPA President for two years, life is a little less congested with only lecturing, judging and PAGB duties demanding attention; thus I can pursue the dream of producing a book of memorable pictures.
